GROHE Sense and GROHE Sense Guard – the Intelligent Helpers for the Smart Home

The technical features of GROHE Sense and GROHE Sense Guard are convincing across the board:

GROHE Sense

- detects leaking water and alerts homeowners via the GROHE ONDUS app as well as with visual and acoustic signals.
- triggers the alert when the two gold-plated pins on the bottom of the device come in contact with water.
- measures the temperature and stores the data every 24 hours in the GROHE ONDUS cloud – if limits were set previously, real-time alerts via the ONDUS app will be sent out if critical amounts are exceeded.
- measures the relative humidity and provides new readings every 24 hours – if the humidity is within a critical range for more than three hours, GROHE Sense will send out an alert via the ONDUS app.





GROHE Sense Guard

- detects burst pipes and automatically turns off the water supply.
- alternatively, the AquaBlock technology offers the option of manually stopping the water.
- detects unusually high water consumption and alerts immediately.
- detects if the inflowing water could cause freezing and sends alerts automatically.
- uses Aqua Track to keep a close eye on the current water consumption.
- ensures the water supply, even in case of power outages.



GROHE Sense Guard & Nest – the Duo for Even More Water Safety

The combination of GROHE Sense Guard and a <u>Nest</u> home automation system provides even greater water safety by automatically shutting off the water supply each time you leave the house. To do this, GROHE Sense Guard will have to be paired with Nest's home / away feature once. Then, if homeowners leave their house, GROHE Sense Guard can automatically close the water pipe and, conversely, reopen it when they return. It uses signals from mobile phones and the activity sensors from Nest and Works with Nest products. A delayed shutdown of the water is also possible (for example if the washing machine is to remain switched on).
