## Maintenance: Filler valve

<b>Water continually flowing into pan, through the internal overflow</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Filler valve not shutting off</li> <li>• Water level has risen above the internal overflow pipe</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Check membrane washer within fill valve for any obstruction caused by debris or damage</li> <li>- adjust polystyrene float on filler valve so that the correct water level is achieved inside the cistern</li> </ul>
<b>Water continually flowing into pan, through the seal in cistern outlet point</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Drop valve not seating</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- check seating washers and seating for any debris or damage around seal, clean if necessary</li> <li>- check seating of discharge valve</li> </ul>
<b>Cistern does not flush, there is no water</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No water supply to the cistern</li> <li>• Air hose connection is impaired</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- check water supply</li> <li>- check isolating valve &amp; any isolating points</li> <li>- check air hose is connected correctly</li> <li>- ensure that the air tube is not kinked</li> </ul>

## General Notes:

### 1. Fill Time/Water Inlet Pressure

- the Grohe filler valve has a blue spiral restrictor, this item can be removed in cases where the inlet water pressure is below 0.5 bar. This will improve the fill time of the water level.

### 2. Water Level

- the polystyrene float on the filler valve regulates the water level for the cistern, the filler valve is factory set to 6 litres and can set to 4,5 litres.

### 3. Air Hose Connections

- check that the air hose is correctly and securely connected, ensure the air hose is connected to the air button and the discharge valve on the cistern.
